APA format

In the references section at the end of your paper:

Langholz, J., and Turner, K. (2008). *You can prevent global warming (and save money!): 51 easy ways*. Kansas City, MO: Andrews McMeel Pub.

In the body of your paper (in text): (Langholz and Turner, 2008)

MLA format

In the works cited section at the end of your paper:

Langholz, Jeffrey, and Kelly Turner. *You Can Prevent Global Warming (and Save Money!): 51 Easy Ways*. Kansas City, MO: Andrews McMeel Pub., 2008. Print.

In text: (Langholz and Turner 124)

Articles

APA format

Example 1 (APA): Article in a print journal, listed in your references:

Atcheson, S. G., Brunner, R. L., Greenwald, E. J., Rivera, V. D. G., Cox, J. C., & Bigos, S. J. (2001). Paying doctors more: Use of musculoskeletal specialists and increased physician pay to decrease workers' compensation costs. *Journal of Occupational and Environmental Medicine*, 43(8), 672-679.

In text: (Atcheson et al., 2001)

Example 2 (APA): Article in an online journal, listed in your references:

Kintisch, E., Charles, D., Guterman, L., Lawler, A., & Mervis, J. (2009, February 20). Science Wins \$21 Billion Boost as Stimulus Package Becomes Law. *Science*, 323 (5917), 992-993. doi: 10.1126/science.323.5917.992

In text: (Kintisch et al., 2009)

MLA format

Example 1 (MLA): Article in a print journal, listed in your works cited:

Atcheson, S. G., et al. "Paying Doctors More: Use of Musculoskeletal Specialists and Increased Physician Pay to Decrease Workers' Compensation Costs." *Journal of Occupational and Environmental Medicine* 43.8 (2001): 672-79. Print.

In text: (Atcheson et al. 673)

Example 2 (MLA): Article in an online journal, listed in your works cited:

Kintisch, Eli, et al. "Science Wins \$21 Billion Boost as Stimulus Package Becomes Law." *Science* 323.5917 (20 Feb. 2009): 992-993. *Academic Search Premier*. Web. 30 Mar. 2009.

In text: (Kintisch et al. 995)
